This lecture by Ana Yepes takes the listener into training practices of the Spanish schools which differed from that of the French and English. Competitive "dance offs" were common in those times and it was often that a dance challenge or even duel would be called between a visiting dancer and the "home team." Yepes will look at the table of steps from this style, emphasizing their unique and virtuosic qualities. Video clips and photos will help to illustrate the dance style.
